

11 School Bus Safety Rules!

- 1. WEAR BRIGHT CLOTHES SO THE BUS DRIVER EASILY SEES YOU.
- 2. GET TO THE BUS STOP AT LEAST 5-10 MINUTES BEFORE THE BUS IS DUE.
- 3. LINE UP QUIETLY IN A SINGLE FILE LINE AWAY FROM THE ROAD.
- 4. NEVER STICK YOUR HANDS, HEAD OR ANY OTHER BODY PARTS OUT THE WINDOWS.
- 5. STAY OUT OF THE DANGER ZONE, WHICH IS 10 FEET AROUND THE BUS ON ALL SIDES.
- 6. TALK QUIETLY AND STAY SEATED ON THE BUS.
- 7. KEEP THE AISLES CLEAR
- 8. PAY ATTENTION TO AND FOLLOW THE DIRECTIONS OF THE BUS DRIVER.
- 9. USE HAND RAILS TO GET ON AND OFF THE BUS.
- 10. DON'T YELL OR PUSH OR THROW THINGS AT THE BUS STOP OR ON THE BUS.
- 11. NEVER STAND OR WALK WHILE THE BUS IS MOVING.
